

Commercial/Residential Apprentice Tools

The tools listed below are suggested for the first year of your apprenticeship. When dispatched to an employer for on the job training, you may be required to provide your own hand tools on any job where your wages are at least two (2) times the minimum wage. It is recommended that you mark your tools with your initials and some identifying number (CDL, Birth date).

(2) adjustable open end pliers (channellock 430)

(2) Adjustable Wrench (Crescent Wrench) 1 - 6", 1 - 8"

assorted screw drivers, (1 each; 4" and 6" Straight Blade, #1 and #2 Phillips)

conduit reamer

hack saw frame

hammer – straight claw 16 oz. minimum

lineman's pliers

needle nose pliers

pencils (6)

screw holding driver for battery drill – 6 inch

diagonal cutting pliers

small note pad

tape measure 25'

electrician's tool pouches with belt

torpedo level (magnetic)

utility (razor) knife

wire strippers – wire #10 - #18

tin snips

keyhole or drywall saw

3/8" drive ratchet and socket set

allen wrench set (hex keys)
