

VDV Apprentice Tools

The tools listed below are suggested for the first year of your apprenticeship. When dispatched to an employer for on the job training, you may be required to provide your own hand tools on any job where your wages are at least two (2) times the minimum wage. It is recommended that you mark your tools with your initials and some identifying number (CDL, Birth date).

3/8" to 1/4" shank drill driver adaptor (example Dewalt PN DW2542)
3/8" x 6" extention
Wire strippers/cutter/crimper (example Klein PN 1010)
Step drill bit/Unibit
Hammer
Standard and metric Allen wrench set
1/4" shank screwdriver adaptor (with extra bits) for a drill (example Dewalt PN DW2055)
