### Important Items to Note:

- [www.goweca.com](http://www.goweca.com) is our main website where you can log in and sign up for class, access student resources, your transcripts, completion certificates, and view your daily grades and attendance for your in progress and past classes.
- [eCampus.goweca.com](http://eCampus.goweca.com) is the website where you log in to attend eCampus classes such as Get Wired and other self-paced courses. Note that there is a calendar on your eCampus home page that includes assignment due dates only. The calendar on eCampus does not include the dates for class lecture days and the date for the onsite in-person lab. Refer to **Upcoming Classes and Required Items** for your full class schedule details (see step 2).
